ARDPI Scholarship Application for the 2012 Brushy Fork Institute

The Appalachian Rural Development Philanthropy Initiative (ARDPI) supports the development of permanent, accessible community foundations that will work to secure local assets in order to provide long-term resources for the distressed communities of Eastern Kentucky.

Through this initiative, The Center for Rural Development will provide scholarships for individuals or teams in our pilot counties to attend the Brushy Fork Institute to pursue planning around local philanthropy. Scholarships are available for individuals who wish to learn how to build social, human, and economic capital in their community.

Scholarship Criteria

- The community you represent must be in one of The Center's ARDPI Pilot counties. Pilot counties are: Bell, Clay, Knox, Magoffin and Whitley.
- At least one person from your team must register for the Community Foundation and Community Transformation Track in order to receive scholarships from The Center.
- If you wish to receive an individual scholarship, you must register for the Community Foundation and Community Transformation Track.
- Teams must be committed to working on a local philanthropy effort.

Registration for the 2012 Brushy Fork Annual Institute is \$500. The Center will offer scholarships for the full cost of registration for up to 20 individuals. Lodging will be the responsibility of each individual or team.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed as received and applicants will be notified as soon as possible. Scholarships are limited so apply early!
